

6th grade: you can continue to work to improve any concert music that you have, practice scales that we have learned in class and even try any that are on your scale sheet that we have not yet played. If your class was given a duet, work on both parts. Use your band book and play exercises that we have already played together and then try taking what you already know to help you play new exercises! But mostly, keep playing your instrument!

5th grade: you can also continue to work to improve any concert music that you have been given. If there are sections that are still difficult to play, go back and "finger and say" so that you learn the patterns before you play. Keep playing your scale to be sure that you have it memorized. Play exercises from your book that we have already played together in class and then take what you already know to help you play something new. But mostly, keep playing!

4th grade: some of you had already received the first piece of concert music, but not everyone. If you do have it, start playing it - but remember to work in small sections by first "fingering and saying, then playing". Everyone can play from the book: both exercises that we have already played together in class and then taking what you already know and moving forward in the book. But mostly, keep playing your instrument!

And everyone can give their families some home concerts!
